Description

This article provides an example of the configuration of a custom NTP server via CLI.

Solution

A custom NTP server can be configured via CLI as follows:

```
config system ntp
set ntpsync enable
set type custom -----> Change type first
set syncinterval 1
config ntpserver
edit 1
set server "1.1.1.1" -----> NTP server IP
set ntpv3 disable
next
end
set source-ip 0.0.0.0
set server-mode disable
end
```
