

What DNS server settings should I be using?

IC provides recursive or caching name servers for you to use.

You can use these from any IC supplied connection. (They are for IC customers only, not the world to use)

| Location | IPv4 Address | IPv6 Address |
|------------|-----------------|------------------|
| London | 193.188.204.100 | 2a02:ac00:1:1::3 |
| Manchester | 193.188.205.100 | 2a02:ac00:2:1::3 |
